

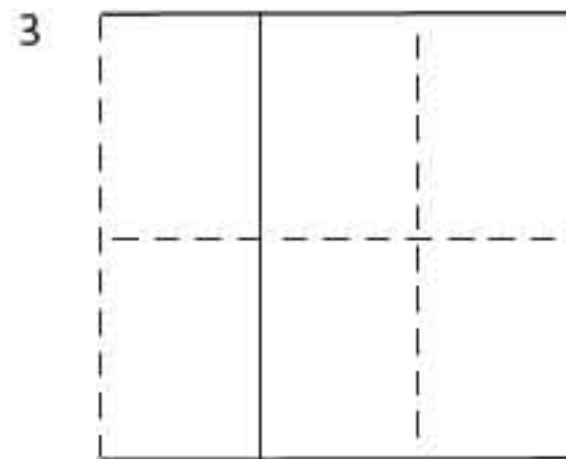
Mini-book Instructions



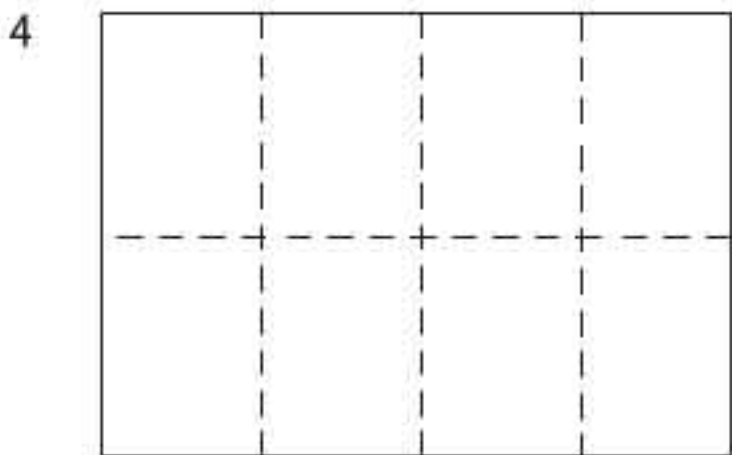
Fold in half long ways



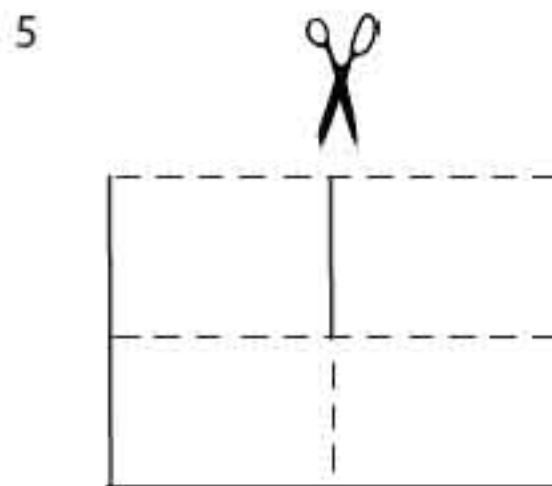
Unfold and then fold in half the other way



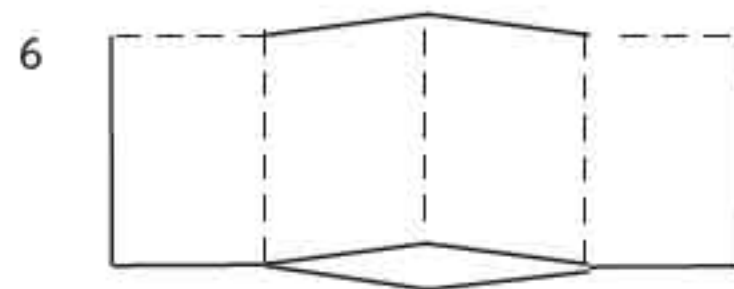
Unfold and then fold the two edges in to meet on the crease line down the middle of the page



Unfold so you have a page with creased lines on it like this



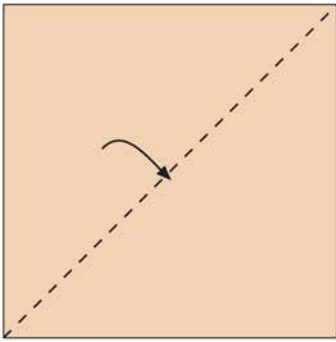
Now fold in half short ways again. Cut along the central line so that the middle two quarters have a slit in them



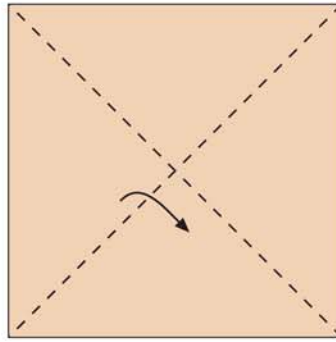
Unfold and refold long ways again and push the two ends towards each other so that it forms a book shape

Tri-o-rama...

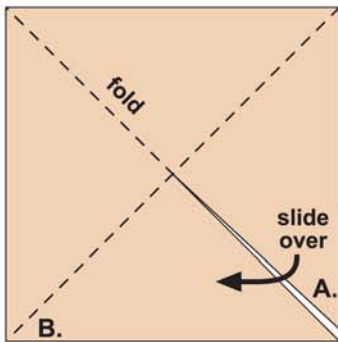
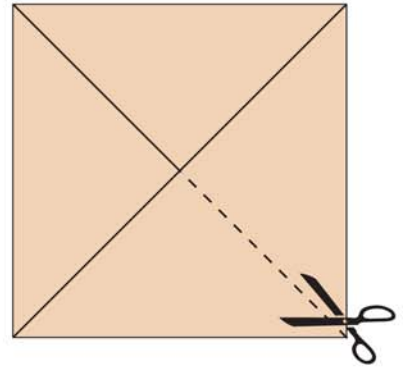
1. Start with a 12" x 12" square of construction paper. Fold in half, corner to corner, to form a triangle.



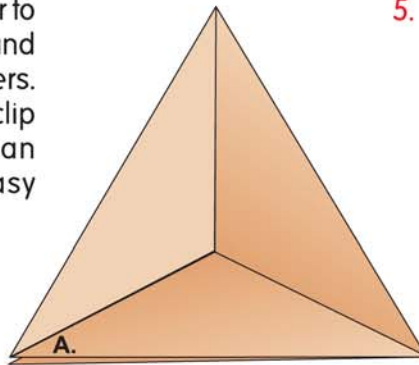
2. Unfold, turn and fold the opposite side. Flip over and refold diagonal again on back side.



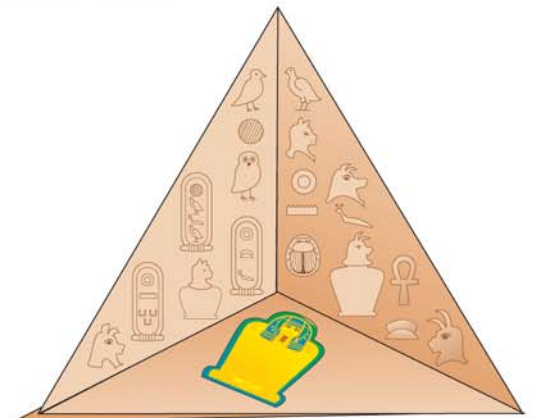
3. Unfold and cut from one corner to the center as shown.



4. Slide point "A." over to match point "B." and glue bottom layers. Or, use a paperclip instead so it can collapse for easy storage. Viola' ...a 3-D Tri-o-rama!



5. Decorate with multi media and make a theme-based creation...it could be the interior of a pyramid, a slice of underwater life, or the habitat for a favorite animal! Use your imagination... the possibilities are endless!
